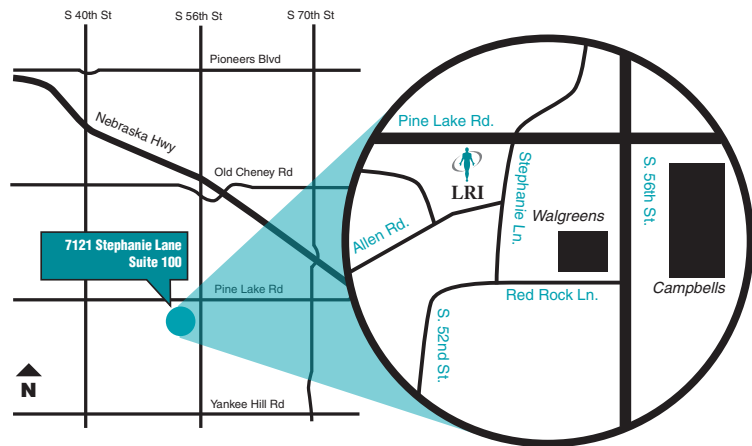

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CT SCAN Contrast: with without Scan Time: 30 Minutes

- ___ **CT Abdomen:** NPO 2 hrs prior to exam. Drink 1 bottle Readi-Cat, 1 hour prior to exam. Keep refrigerated.
 - ___ **CT Abdomen/Pelvis:** NPO 2 hrs prior to exam. You will receive 2 bottles of Readi-Cat. Keep refrigerated. (1) Drink 1 bottle Readi-Cat the night before exam. (2) Drink 1/2 bottle Readi-Cat 1 hour prior to exam. (3) Bring remaining Readi-Cat to exam.
 - ___ **CT Pelvis:** Same preparation as CT Abdomen/Pelvis with contrast. No prep for pelvic bone scans.

ULTRASOUND Scan Time: 30-45 Minutes

- ___ **Abdomen:** NPO 6 hrs prior to exam.
- ___ **Pelvis:** Drink plenty of fluids (approximately 40 oz or 5 glasses of liquid) 1-2 hours prior to exam. Do NOT empty bladder.
- ___ **OB:** Drink plenty of fluids (approximately 40 oz or 5 glasses of liquid) 1-2 hours prior to exam. Do NOT empty bladder.

PET/CT SCAN Oncologic: Diagnosis Staging Re-staging Scan Time: 60-90 Minutes

- ___ **PET Whole Body (Oncology):** NPO 4 hrs prior to exam. Patient may take regularly scheduled meds with water only. No diuretic on day of exam (i.e. Lasix). If pain or anti-anxiety meds are needed, please have patient bring those medications on day of exam and technologists will instruct patient when to take them. Do not exercise and also limit carbohydrate intake (bread, pasta, potatoes and rice) 24 hours prior to your scan. Wear comfortable clothing. (specify cancer type) _____
 - ___ **PET Brain (Neurology):** NPO 4 hrs prior to exam. Patient may take regularly scheduled meds with water only. No diuretic on day of exam (i.e. Lasix). If pain or anti-anxiety meds are needed, please have patient bring those medications on day of exam and technologists will instruct patient when to take them. Take insulin as normally instructed.
- NOTE:** If patient had radiation, chemotherapy or gamma knife treatments, schedule patient at least 10 days following date of last treatment.

NUCLEAR MEDICINE Scan Time: Varies Per Procedure

- ___ **Bone Scan (Three Phase Bone Scan: __yes __no):** Procedure time approximately 4-5 hours.
- ___ **Renal (Lasix: __yes __no):** Drink plenty of liquids day of exam. Procedure time approximately 1 hour.
- ___ **Hepatobiliary (HIDA/PIPIDA) Scan (CCK for Ejection Fraction: __yes __no):** NPO 6 hrs prior to exam. Patients should not take morphine or certain pain medications the day of exam. Procedure time approximately 2 hours.
